What: Bay Shore Parade
The 10th annual Bay Shore/Brightwaters St. Patrick's Day parade steps off at 2 p.m. at Saxon Avenue and proceeds 1.6 miles down Montauk Highway to the

receiving stand at St. Patrick's Church.
When: Saturday, March 13 at 2 p.m.
Spectacle: There will be a mass before the parade at noon.
