Mirabelle Restaurant & Tavern, Stony Brook



This French inspired restaurant has a pair of seating options: a formal white-tablecloth dining room for couples craving one of *those* kinds of dinners and a cozy tavern with a brick fireplace and checkered throw pillows for diners who prefer a jeans-and-a-button-down vibe. Either way, Chef Guy Reuge's three-course menu will delight, especially when bookended with oysters served with Champagne-mignonette and a passion fruit mousse cake that tastes as festive as it sounds. **Go**
